




## How to resolve Waste Tank Full – Printing Stopped on the DM50 / DM55 (K721)

Your meter will display a message when its Waste Tray (also called a Waste Tank) has neared capacity. Once it is actually full, the Waste Tray foam may need to be replaced.

Sometimes the waste tray full message displays prematurely. You can visually check the tray to make sure it is not fully saturated. If it is full, you can follow these steps to replace it.

Checking the waste tank:	
<p>Looking at the back of the machine, locate the button on the bottom right corner.</p> <p>Slide the button to the right and hold in place.</p>	
<p>Pull the ink tray out from the bottom-rear of meter.</p> <p>Release the button.</p> <p>Check that the tray is fully saturated with ink. If it looks like it isn't near capacity, you will be able to continue using the meter without a replacement tray.</p>	
<p>Slide the tray back into the meter.</p>	

Press the **Options** key.

Press the **Yes/Enter** key.



Use **Review** keys to scroll to *Replace Waste Ink Tray?*



Press the **Yes/Enter** key.

Enter the four-digit code: . . **57** (dot, dot, 5, 7).

Press the **Yes/Enter** key.
