OUR USPS® PARTNERSHIP

- We leverage the USPS for last-mile delivery instead of building out a redundant, environmentally harmful infrastructure.
- Our parcels enjoy a "free" ride to their final mile destination.
- Our environmental footprint is significantly smaller than private carriers.

MINIMIZING RELIANCE ON SINGLE-USE MATERIALS

- Corrugate recycling at each fulfillment, delivery and returns facility allows us to reduce, reuse and recycle all used gaylords.
- Most of our corrugate in use today is made of at least 35% post-consumer recycled materials; some units as much as 50%.
- When possible, we leverage reusable plastic pallets in lieu of wooden pallets. On average, plastics pallets make 250 trips as opposed to only 5-6 for wooden.
- We've reduced our shrink wrap usage by 20% since 2019.

OUR DIFFERENTIATORS

- In 1980, our sustainability efforts were formalized with the creation of our corporate responsibility committee.
- As an EPA SmartWay partner, we've improved the environmental performance of our vehicles through hardware and software advances.
- We earned the 2020 Climate Leadership Award for Excellence in Greenhouse Gas Management from the Center for Climate and Energy Solutions for improving energy efficiency and driving down our environmental footprint.
- We continue to purchase Renewable Energy Credits (RECs), which support green power projects.
